

Installation guide for Meta Quest 3

1) Create a developer Account

- ▶ Got to: <https://developer.oculus.com/manage/organizations/create/>
- ▶ Create an organization and type in any organization name and activate „I understand“
- ▶ Finally submit by clicking on the green button



2) Quest 2 + Quest 3 Smartphone app

Download the Quest 2 or Quest 3 smartphone app

- ▶ **Apple iOS:** <https://apps.apple.com/de/app/meta-quest/id1366478176>
- ▶ **Android:** <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.oculus.twilight>
- ▶ Log in with your credentials you just have created in step 1):
 - ▶ Your email and your password
 - ▶ Then pair the Smartphone App with your Quest 2 or Quest 3
 - ▶ In the smartphone app:
 - ▶ When both devices are connected click on the Quest 2 or Quest 3 picture at the top of the app
 - ▶ Click on **Headset settings / Developer mode** and switch the button to **on**
 - ▶ In Quest 2 or Quest 3:
 - ▶ **Restart** your Quest 2 or Quest 3 first
 - ▶ After restart click on the battery and time symbol in the dock to open the “Quick Settings”
 - ▶ Click on the “Settings” **gear wheel** symbol in the top right, then on **System** in the main settings selection (the first entry on the left) and then on **Developer** on the left side in the selection menu. Then click on **Enable Custom Settings**
 - ▶ Your Quest 2 or Quest 3 is now in developer mode

3) Download & unzip the Magic Horizons VR software

- ▶ Use the download link which Magic Horizons has provided to download our VR software
- ▶ It will be a large file **in zipped format** like **90 to 100 GB**. Please make sure that you have a **good internet connection**. There must be **twice as much free space** on your internal or external hard disc on your PC or Mac when you unzip the file (approx. **190 GB+**)
- ▶ **Unzip** the downloaded file on your PC or Mac. Afterwards you can delete the zip file.
- ▶ Inside the unzipped “Deploy“ folder you will see then 2 files:
 - ▶ The large Magic Horizons media storage folder (**90 - 100 GB**)
 - ▶ The APK (= the app) itself (approx. only **700 MB**)




4) Install Magic Horizons APK via SideQuest


Download Sidequest:

- ▶ Go to download Sidequest at: <https://sidequestvr.com/setup-howto>
- ▶ We recommend to use the **Advanced Installer** of Sidequest
- ▶ Connect your Quest 2 or Quest 3 via USB-C cable with a PC or Mac
- ▶ For a **Mac** you need a free program like Android File Transfer
- ▶ Inside Quest 2 or Quest 3 in **Notifications** in the dock at the left side appears a **blue dot**
- ▶ Click on the **Notification** and **allow** the USB connection to a PC or Mac
- ▶ Install the Magic Horizons APK as described with the program Sidequest
- ▶ In case an older Magic Horizons APK is already installed on the VR glasses please **uninstall this old version first** (described later)


1) Install button




- Wait for approx. 2-3 minutes while the APP installation is in progress
- **Do not interrupt** the installation process and do not start any other tasks on your computer while the installation is running



- When the message jumps to **green** the installation is finished



- Switch to “App Overview Tab” to see if the Magic Horizons App is installed




5) Start the Magic Horizons app

In the main Quest 2 or Quest 3 menu:

- 1) First click on the **App launcher** symbol in the dock
- 2) Then as step 2: click in the **search field**




- Activate **Unknown Sources** at the end of the list in the selection bar at the top



Start the Magic Horizons app:


- After the Magic Horizons app has started the first time: type in the correct **license key** which you have received from Magic Horizons
- The license key consists of **4 digits, a hyphen** and again of **4 digits**, for example: [y23g-14rt](#)
- Please make sure to type in **exactly in this format** the numbers or letters **including the hyphen** of the license key
- Make sure that a **0** (= zero) and an **O** (= letter "O") as well as an **i** (= letter "i") or an **I** (= letter "l") are not mixed up
- It is mandatory to start the Magic Horizons app **first**: this will create the correct folders where to place the **Magic Horizons (MediaStorage)** folder in the next step



6) Install the Magic Horizons Media Storage folder

Installation of the **MagicHorizons(MediaStorage)** folder:


- ▶ Place the **MagicHorizons(MediaStorage)** folder exactly in: **Android / data / com.magichorizons.b2bpico / files**
- ▶ The **MagicHorizons(MediaStorage)** folder must be placed **exactly** in this location and must not be renamed: otherwise the Magic Horizons app would not work correctly.



7) Finishing the installation

After copying the Media Storage folder:

- ▶ Restart your Quest 2 or Quest 3 again by switching it off and on
- ▶ Start the Magic Horizons app as described in 5)
- ▶ When the permission prompt appears press: **Allow** to access the internal media.
- ▶ The prompt appears only for the first start. **Allow is important** - otherwise the media is not played back
- ▶ Then always use the same procedure to launch the Magic Horizons app:
 - ▶ Start the App launcher / Search Field /Unknown Sources / Magic Horizons App
 - ▶ Or use the **Magic Horizons symbol** in the **dock** to launch the app



Press: allow

- ▶ After a successful installation switch **off** the VR glasses by long pressing the On/Off button. Switch **on** the VR glasses again.
- ▶ Launch the Magic Horizons App
- ▶ Finally do a **quick check** in "Single Applications": start one **nature video**, one **interactive application** and one **binaural beat** to see that the app and the corresponding content is loaded correctly.
